## Part-Time Enrollment Options

	Graduation/Diploma (Grades 9-12)	Independent Study (Grades 1-12)
<b>Bible Credit</b>	One credit of Bible is required to be taken AT NCS each year	One credit Bible is required to be reported each year to NCS from either homeschool coursework OR NCS Bible class  Homeschool Bible credits must be pre-approved by NCS administration from a trusted curriculum or instructional provider
<b>Credit Requirements</b>	Including the required NCS Bible credit each year, students must accumulate at least 12 credits in order to graduate with a diploma from NCS  Students must meet all NCS Graduation Requirements (either homeschool or NCS). Homeschool credits must be approved by NCS for transference toward an NCS diploma.  A minimum of 2 NCS credits per year is required  If a student takes 4 or more NCS credits in a school year, they will be enrolled as a full-time student.	Families may choose any number of elective or disciplinary credits to take each year
<b>Chapel / Spiritual-Focused Activities</b>	Students are required to participate in weekly chapels and any scheduled Spiritual-focused activities (i.e. student retreat days or week-long chapel series). A lack of consistent attendance will result in communication or discipline from NCS Administration.	Students are required to consistently participate in weekly chapels and any week-long chapel series. A lack of consistent attendance will result in communication or discipline from NCS Administration.
<b>Official Credit Verification</b>	Students will be permitted to participate in graduation events, receive a Northside Christian School issued diploma, as well as receive a final transcript (including all credits received through NCS and homeschool)	Students will receive a final transcript that includes all credit received at Northside Christian School
